## Mason Police Logs: June 18-24, 2017

### Sunday June 18

12:55pm Check Conditions – Officer checked on Mason quarry for nonresidents.

1:07pm Check Conditions – Officer checked on Mason quarry for nonresidents and requested 5 nonresidents leave.

### Monday June 19

6:56am Vin Verification – A resident of Churchill Road asked if an officer could call when he was available to go to the home for a vin verification.

4:11pm Vin Verification – Services rendered on a call from earlier in the day.

4:46pm Criminal Trespass – Officer checked on Mason quarry and requested 6 nonresidents leave.

6:28pm Criminal Trespass – Officer responded to an issue of parking on private property at the end of Scripts Lane. Owner of property does not want vehicles parking in his property.
