

Mason Police Department Press Release

Depot Rd. Incident

On May 9th, 2015 at approximately 2:04pm the Brookline Police Department took a report that a man in a car on Mason Rd. in Brookline had threatened another motorist who had stopped to assist a child who had fallen off a bicycle, by pointing a firearm at the good Samaritan.

Subsequent investigation by the Brookline Police Department identified the man with the gun as Alfred Stauble, 85, of 467 Depot Rd. in Mason NH. At 2:17pm officers from the Brookline Police Department and Mason Police Department arrived at Stauble's residence and tried making contact with the suspect. Stauble refused to exit his residence to speak with the officers. Based on previous contacts with Stauble the NH State Police Tactical Team was called in to assist and an Arrest and Search Warrant for Stauble and the residence were secured by a judge.

At 6:52pm Stauble was taken into custody after several hours of negotiations by the State Police Tactical Team. Officers from the Hollis and New Ipswich Police Departments assisted State Police, Brookline and the Mason Police Departments. During the standoff surrounding residences on Depot Rd. were evacuated and Depot Rd. was closed off. Multiple firearms were seized during the execution of the search warrant.

UPDATE: 5/13/2015

Stauble was arraigned in the Milford District Court on Monday morning, May 11th. on a Felony Criminal Threatening and is currently being held at the Hillsborough County House of Corrections on \$10,000 cash or surety bail. Resisting Arrest charges forthcoming from Mason PD.
